SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus' program for becoming children of the Kingdom of Heaven is presented in a series of contrasts between what the law of Moses commands and how Jesus' teaching brings that law to fulfillment. We hear four such contrasts today. Jesus makes it clear that He has come not to abolish but to fulfill the Mosaic Law and the prophets. He challenges us to have our righteousness, that is, our right relationship with God and others, exceed that of the teachers of His day. Today's Gospel contrasts what the law says about murder, adultery, divorce, and taking oaths with Jesus' teaching on these matters. In a world of preventative strikes, Jesus forbids even anger. For Jesus, reconciliation has priority even over worship; adultery includes yielding to lust for another; and speaking with simplicity and integrity renders oath-taking unnecessary. Sirach encourages us: If we choose, we can keep the Commandments and they will save us; if we trust in God, we shall live. Paul refers to God's wisdom as not identified with that of this age.

How is the Spirit calling you to trust that God's wisdom and strength will become yours?

Good or Evil, Choose One

Today we are reminded about human choice and the consequences of each choice. We are also reminded that God observes all human action. The Gospel reading says "Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be least in the kingdom of God."

The Ten Commandments teach us how to live as God wants us to. We must be reconciled with God and one another. Remember the two greatest commandments: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and mind." The second commandment is "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

All students in our Religious Education program dialogue each week with their Catechists and class about the previous Sunday's readings and the message they heard. Our students and parents are reminded of the importance of attending Mass on Sundays and holy days knowing that celebrating Mass together is the central act of Catholic worship, the source and summit of our Catholic life. "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord." (today's Responsorial Psalm response). We are to be glad and rejoice. The Beatitudes translated means "happy." If we want to be truly happy we are to center our lives on God. Jesus lived what he preached and we must become like Jesus and we will be able to do what Jesus tells us to do: "Be glad and rejoice for your reward in heaven is great."
