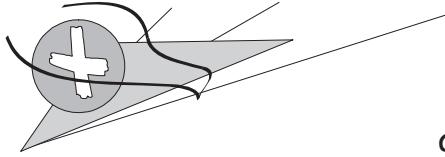

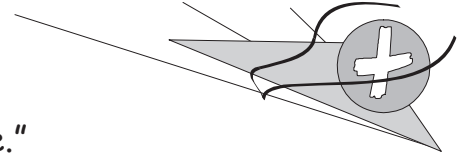

We Belong to God

Our spiritual happiness depends on what we have done to serve God and the good works we have done for others.

Jesus comes to us in the Eucharist to share His life with us. We come to receive Jesus, rest and ask Him to help us on our faith journey to our heavenly Father.

Preparing to Receive the Eucharist

We show respect and love for Jesus by fasting before we receive the Eucharist. We do not eat or drink anything for one hour before receiving. However, water and medicine may be taken.

Reception of the Eucharist (Holy Communion)

The Eucharist may be received on the tongue or in the hand. When approaching the Priest / Deacon / Eucharistic Minister, make a simple head bow indicating reverence. The ministers will say "the Body of Christ" (the Blood of Christ if under both species). The communicant responds "Amen" (It is true). We believe in the presence of Christ and we thank God for the Gift of Jesus Christ. If you wish to receive in your hand, extend an open hand up toward the minister so they can place the Eucharist in the palm of your hand. Your other hand is placed under the hand receiving the Eucharist. Once the Eucharist is put in your hand, the other hand is used to pick up the Eucharist and put *It* immediately in your mouth in front of the minister.

Receiving a Blessing at Communion

Children who have not completed the necessary sacramental training and have not received their First Holy Communion as well as adults who cannot receive Communion (mostly non-Catholics) may approach a Priest and/or Deacon with their arms crossed to receive a blessing.
