The two greatest Commandments that contain the whole law of God are:

1. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest Commandment.
2. The second is like it: Thou shall love your neighbor as yourself.

NEW CHRISTMAS MOVIE FOR CHILDREN

Faith and love are difficult, the main characters find. Mary and Joseph are overwhelmed with the prospect of raising the Messiah, but continually pray to God for strength. They are unknowingly dogged by henchmen of King Herod's, and as Bo works behind the scenes to save Mary, he is never thanked for what he is doing and continues without recognition. Two reformed bad guys admit they have to keep trying toward goodness. The film is neither preachy nor cloying. It's subtle yet moving themes are sure to delight audiences—and maybe even change hearts.
